

May 14, 2018

The City Council met in the Council Room on May 14, 2018 with the following members present: Chuck Steffenson, Monica Olson, Darek Buse, Bobbie Batesole & Richard Novotny and the following absent: NONE

Others Present: Julie Aasness, Ardell Hendrickson, Colleen Shores, Tyler Anderson, Duaine Burros, Dave Bedore, Jerry Buse and Diana K. Olson

All present stood to say the pledge of allegiance.

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM by Mayor Olson.

A motion was made by Novotny, seconded by Buse and carried to approve the May 14th agenda with the addition of Dental Clinic Building.

A motion was made by Batesole, seconded by Novotny and carried to approve the April 9th Council Minutes and April 17th Board of Review.

A motion was made by Batesole, seconded by Novotny and carried to approve a Bingo permit from the American Legion Post 188 to conduct BINGO on July 6th at the Community Center.

A motion was made by Steffenson, seconded by Novotny and carried to accept the bid from Tyler Anderson in the amount of \$2.00 to purchase the Dental Clinic building.

A motion was made by Novotny, seconded by Steffenson and carried to have Tyler pay ½ of the closing costs and the City will pay the other half.

The Council discussed the EDA and has not heard anything from the people about developing a group. The Council would like to use the same colors as the City of Remer for the new tower. We are looking for someone to plant, water and maintain the flowers throughout the City. If there is a person or group interested they should contact City Hall. The City will pay for flowers up to \$250.

A motion was made by Batesole, seconded by Novotny and carried to rent the porta-potties from HPS Rentals this year and add an ADA one in the park.

A motion was made by Novotny, seconded by Steffenson and carried to hire APC for street sweeping for the rate of \$125/per hour per machine.

A motion was made by Steffenson, seconded by Buse and carried to hire Bargen to install replay on various streets in the amount of \$31,253.99 and nuvo gap to various streets in the amount of \$14,169.95.

A motion was made by Steffenson, seconded by Novotny and carried to purchase a new volleyball net, seats for the swings in the park, the broken piece for the playscape and 2 new basketball hoops & poles.

A motion was made by Novotny, seconded by Steffenson and carried to approve the loader maintenance agreement with Ziegler Cat.

Monica is working on getting more quotes for the website.

Monica & Bobbie are working on the school lease.
Chuck & Monica are to meet with Ron Johnson about the detachment.

A motion was made by Buse, seconded by Batesole and carried to approve a structure permit from Nancy Neterval to build a deck on the front of the house as long as she abides by the setbacks. It is parcel 72-0339-000.

A motion was made by Steffenson, seconded by Novonty and carried to approve a structure permit from Sherwin Carlson to build a canopy over the front of this building as long as he abides by the setbacks. It is parcel 72-0354-935.

A motion was made by Steffenson, seconded by Buse and carried to allow pre-taxed insurance and deductions for employees and have the AT Group administer the deductions.

A motion was made by Buse, seconded by Novotny and carried to have the City request funds on behalf of the Community Club for the Historical Foundation & Fire Department for the July celebration.

A motion was made by Novotny, seconded by Batesole and carried to contribute \$600 towards the Evansville's Red, White & Boom Celebration which will be July 6 & 7th.

Gardonville will be installing new fiber lines in town.
Watermain flushing will be within the next 3 weeks.
The County will be cleaning the County ditch that runs through town.

A motion was made by Novonty, seconded by Steffenson and carried to donate \$1,500 towards the Summer Recreation program.

There have been numerous complaints about resident's properties. Council will think of ways to clean up the town.

A motion was made by Buse, seconded by Novonty and carried to approve the May bills and authorize payment. (List Attached)

A motion was made by Buse, seconded by Batesole and carried to adjourn the meeting at 8:30 PM.
